

## **Dadi Janki – Chief of Brahma Kumaris**

Dadi (Elder Sister) Janki has dedicated more than 70 years of her life to the work of the Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya (Brahma Kumaris World Spiritual University) of which she is the Administrative Head. She began her spiritual apprenticeship in 1937 at the age of 21 and was one of the founding members. After serving throughout India in the years following independence, she moved to London, UK, in 1974 and from there her vision and drive saw the organisation's teachings carried into more than 105 countries.

Now internationally acknowledged as a great spiritual leader, Dadi's lifelong focus has been to align her mind and heart to God's will and purpose. She experiences God as a source of pure love and wisdom, and has made those qualities the foundation of her life.

Through this structured and disciplined method of spiritual development, she has shown thousands of people of all background and walks of life how to regain true self-respect, becoming free of addictive and negative tendencies and thereby able to contribute more to present-day society as well as a future world. Dadi Janki maintains an unrivalled daily lecture and touring schedule even today, at age 100. She is a soul who refuses to set limits and boundaries as to what is achievable and, in so doing, inspires others to believe that they too can make the impossible, possible.
